Mr. Speaker,

The Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 262**, UPSTART AMENDMENTS, by Senator J. Stuart Adams, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 16 through 18:
 - requires a contractor to work with the Department of Workforce Services and the
 - 17 State Board of Education to solicit certain families to participate in UPSTART; {-and -}
 - <u>▶ authorizes a contractor to request certain information to verify an individual's income; and</u>
 - 18 makes technical corrections.
- 2. Page 5, Lines 138 through 140:
 - Section 4. Section **53A-1a-1004** is amended to read:
 - 53A-1a-1004. Family participation in UPSTART <u>- Low income family</u> verification .
 - 140 (1) The contractor shall:
- 3. Page 6, Lines 167 through 168:
 - in Subsection (4)(a).

(5)(a) The contrator shall:

(i) determine if a family is a low income family for purposes of this part;

<u>and</u>

(ii) use the same application form as described in Section 35A-9-401 or create an application form that requires an individual to provide and certify the

> information necessary for the contractor to make the determination described in Subsection (5)(a)(i).

(b) The contractor may:

(i) require an individual to submit supporting documentation; and

(ii) create a deadline for an individual to submit an application, if

necessary.
