Senator **Jacob L. Anderegg** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 57 through 65:*

57            (b) Notwithstanding Subsection 13-1-2(3)(c), the Department of Commerce shall  
58 deposit a fee assessed under this section into the Public Utility Regulatory Restricted Account.

59            (c) Within appropriations by the Legislature:

60            (i) the Department of Commerce may use the funds in the Public Utility Regulatory  
61 Restricted Account to administer:

62            (A) the Division of Public Utilities; and

63            (B) the Office of Consumer Services; and

64            (ii) the Public Service Commission may use the funds in the Public Utility Regulatory  
65 Restricted Account to administer the Public Service Commission.

**(d) At the end of each fiscal year, the director of the Division of Finance shall transfer into the General Fund any balance in the Public Utility Regulatory Restricted Account in excess of \$3,000,000.**

2. *Page 6, Lines 157 through 158:*
