Representative **Steve Eliason** proposes the following amendments:

 - 15 agencies to employ licensed school counselors <u>or licensed clinical social workers</u>; and
 - requires a local education agency that receives a grant to make an annual report to
- 2. Page 2, Lines 41 through 49:
 - 41 (i) serves students in any one or all of grades kindergarten through grade 6; and
 - 42 (ii) (A) does not employ a licensed school counselor or licensed clinical social worker at the school for which the LEA
 - 43 plans to employ the licensed school counselor or licensed clinical social worker application for a grant to the
 - 44 board; or
 - 45 (B) already employs at the time of grant application a licensed school counselor or licensed clinical social worker at the
 - 46 <u>school for which the LEA plans to employ an additional licensed counselor</u> <u>or licensed clinical social</u> <u>worker</u> <u>through grant</u>
