**GRANDPARENT VISITATION AMENDMENTS**

Representative **LaVar Christensen** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 37 through 44:*

37 **(3) An adoptive parent may request and a court may require that grandparent visitation be supervised, in accordance with the applicable guidelines provided in Section 30-3-34.5.**

38 ~~{(3)}~~ **(4)** For all involuntary terminations and subsequent adoptions by a relative made after  
39 October 1, 2017, the one-time petition described in Subsection (2) shall be heard and decided  
40 at or before the time of the final adoption decision, with notice given to the proposed adoptive  
41 parents ~~{of the petition}~~ .

42 ~~{(4)}~~ **(5)** If a court has issued a final adoption decree, a court may not consider **under this section** a petition for  
43 grandparent visitation that is filed after October 1, 2017.

**(6) An individual who files an action under this section for grandparent visitation of a child and who does not prevail in the action is barred from bringing a subsequent action for grandparent visitation of the same child.**

**(7) The provisions of this section do not apply to a private adoption by a non-relative of a child.**

43 ~~{(5)}~~ **(8)** Grandparent visitation may also be determined by a post adoption contract  
44 agreement, as described in Section 78B-6-146.
