OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING AMENDMENTS

Representative **Norman K Thurston** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page , Line 28 through Page 2, Line 29:*

28 (1) [~~(a) The division may~~] Subject to Subsections (2) and (3), the division {~~shall~~} **may** issue a

35 (b) after being licensed outside of this state, the person has at least one year of

37 the license was issued and the division determines the person has the education, experience,
38 and skills necessary to demonstrate competency in the occupation or profession for which
39 licensure is sought.
