Senator **Todd Weiler** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 11 through 14:
  - 11 This bill:
    - requires a county clerk, to the extent possible, to ensure that the waiting time in line at a polling location does not exceed 30 minutes;

  - 13 amount of time } <u>at the next election if</u> an individual waits in line <u>more than 30 minutes</u> before the individual can vote at a polling
  - 14 location.
- 2. Page 3, Lines 76 through 83:
  - 76 <u>(6) (a) Each county clerk shall</u> {<u>create a line management plan to</u>}, <u>to the extent possible</u>, ensure that the amount
  - 77 of time that an individual waits in line before the individual can vote at a polling location in the
  - 78 county does not exceed 30 minutes.
  - 79 {<u>(b) On or before January 1 of each even-numbered year, each county clerk shall submit</u>
  - 80 <u>a new or updated plan described in Subsection (6)(a) to the lieutenant governor.</u>}

<u>(b) The lieutenant governor may require a county clerk to submit a line management plan before the</u> <u>next election if an individual waits in line at a polling location in the county longer than 30 minutes</u> <u>before the individual can vote.</u>

(c) The lieutenant governor may consider extenuating circumstances in deciding whether to require the county clerk to submit a plan described in Subsection (6)(b).

- 82 and consult with the county clerk submitting the plan to {<u>improve the plan's effectiveness and</u>
