LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY AND FIREFIGHTER SURVIVING SPOUSE TRUST FUND  
AMENDMENTS

Senator **Todd Weiler** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Line 45:

2. Page 2, Line 51 through Page 3, Line 68:
