27	Section 1. Section <b>76-10-113</b> is enacted to read:
28	76-10-113. Restriction on tobacco use on capitol hill complex Penalties.
29	(1) As used in this section:
30	(a) "Board" means the State Capitol Preservation Board created in Section 63C-9-201.
31	(b) "Capitol hill complex" means the same as that term is defined in Section
32	<u>63C-9-102.</u>
33	(c) "Smoking" means the same as that term is defined in Section 26-38-2.
34	(d) (i) "Tobacco" means:
35	(A) a cigarette or a tobacco product, as those terms are defined in Section 59-14-102;

38	(ii) "Tobacco" does not include a cessation product specifically approved by the United

41	prohibited indoors and outdoors at the capitol hill complex.
42	(3) (a) A person who violates Subsection (2) is guilty of an infraction and is subject to

44	(b) (i) A first violation of Subsection (2) is subject to a fine of not more than \$100.
45	(ii) A second or subsequent violation of Subsection (2) is subject to a fine of not less
46	than \$100 and not more than \$500.
47	(c) Before July 1, 2019, a peace officer:
48	(i) may not issue a citation to an individual who violates this section; and
49	(ii) shall issue a warning to an individual who violates this section, informing the

73	26, Chapter 38, Utah Indoor Clean Air Act, the provisions of this section are controlling.
