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### LONG TITLE

#### General Description:

This bill prohibits ~~{flight}~~certain operations of an unmanned aircraft ~~{within a certain distance of a}~~system related to correctional ~~{facility}~~facilities.

#### Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ defines "correctional facility";~~{"}~~
- ▶ prohibits ~~{flight}~~the operation of an unmanned aircraft ~~{within a certain radius}~~system:
  - to deliver any item to or inside the property of a correctional facility; or
  - in a manner that interferes with the operations or security of a correctional facility; and
- ▶ ~~{provides certain exemptions}~~makes technical changes.

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*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **72-14-102** is amended to read:

**72-14-102. Definitions.**

As used in this chapter:

- (1) "Airport" means the same as that term is defined in Section 72-10-102.
- (2) "Airport operator" means the same as that term is defined in Section 72-10-102.
- (3) "Correctional facility" means the same as that term is defined in ~~Sections 64-13-1~~  
~~and~~ ~~Section~~ ~~77-16b-102~~.

~~(3)~~ (4) "Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft that is:

- (a) capable of sustaining flight; and
- (b) operated with no possible direct human intervention from on or within the aircraft.

~~(4)~~ (5) "Unmanned aircraft system" means the entire system used to operate an unmanned aircraft, including:

- (a) the unmanned aircraft, including payload;
- (b) communications equipment;
- (c) navigation equipment;
- (d) controllers;
- (e) support equipment; and
- (f) autopilot functionality.

Section 2. Section **72-14-304** is enacted to read:

**72-14-304. Unlawful operation of unmanned aircraft near prison facilities** ==

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### Penalties.

(1) ~~{Except as provided in Subsection (2), a person}~~ An individual may not ~~{fly}~~ operate an unmanned aircraft ~~{within one-quarter of a mile}~~ system:

(a) to carry or drop any item to or inside the property of a correctional facility; or

(b) in a manner that interferes with the operations or security of a correctional facility.

(2) ~~{ Subsection (1) does not apply to a person flying an unmanned aircraft as part of an official function of:~~

~~—— (a) an educational institution;~~

~~—— (b) a law enforcement agency;~~

~~—— (c) a government agency; or~~

~~—— (d) a political subdivision of this state.~~
