LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the responsibilities of the Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL).

Highlighted Provisions:

- ▶ modifies the authority of DOPL to issue licenses to individuals who have been previously licensed in another state, district, or territory of the United States; and
- ▶ makes technical changes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:



26 Section 1. Section **58-1-302** is amended to read:

27 **58-1-302. License by endorsement.**

28 (1) As used in this section:

29 (a) "Domicile" means the place where an individual has a fixed permanent home.

30 (b) "Resident" means an individual who:

31 (i) has established a domicile in this state;

32 (ii) engages in a trade, profession, or occupation in this state, or who accepts

33 employment in other than seasonal work in this state, and who does not commute into the state;

34 or

35 (iii) has a valid Utah driver license.

36 ~~[(1)]~~ (2) [(a) The division may] Subject to Subsections (3) and (4), the division may

37 issue a license without examination to a ~~[person]~~ resident who has been licensed in a state,

38 district, or territory of the United States~~[-]~~ or in a foreign country~~[-, where]~~ if:

39 (a) the division determines the education, experience, and examination requirements

40 ~~[are, or were]~~ of the state, district, or territory of the United States or the foreign country, at the

41 time the license was issued, were substantially equal to the current requirements of this state~~[-];~~

43 (b) after being licensed outside of this state, the resident has at least one year of

44 experience in the state, district, or territory of the United States where the license was issued,

45 and the division determines the resident has the education, experience, and skills necessary to

46 demonstrate competency in the occupation or profession for which licensure is sought.

47 ~~[(b)]~~ (3) The division, in consultation with the applicable licensing board, may make

48 rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act,

49 prescribing the requirements of ~~[this]~~ Subsection ~~[(1)]~~ (2).

50 ~~[(2)]~~ (4) Before a ~~[person]~~ resident may be issued a license under this section, the

51 ~~[person]~~ resident shall:

52 (a) pay a fee determined by the department under Section [63J-1-504](#); and

53 (b) produce satisfactory evidence of the ~~[person's]~~ resident's identity, qualifications, and

54 good standing in the occupation or profession for which licensure is sought.
