28	Civil penalties prohibited Exceptions.
29	(1) The governing body of each municipality may impose a criminal penalty for the
30	violation of any municipal ordinance by a fine not to exceed the maximum class B
31	misdemeanor fine under Section 76-3-301 or by a term of imprisonment up to six months, or
32	by both the fine and term of imprisonment.
33	(2) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (2)(b), the governing body may prescribe a
34	civil penalty for the violation of any municipal ordinance by a fine not to exceed the maximum
35	class B misdemeanor fine under Section 76-3-301.
36	(b) A municipality may not impose a civil penalty and adjudication for the violation of
37	a municipal moving traffic ordinance.
38	[(3) A municipal officer or official who is not a law enforcement officer in accordance
39	with Section 53-13-103 may not issue a criminal citation for a violation that is punished as a
40	misdemeanor.]
41	Section 2. Section 77-7-18 is amended to read:
42	77-7-18. Citation on misdemeanor or infraction charge.
43	(1) Any person subject to arrest or prosecution on a misdemeanor or infraction charge
44	may be issued and delivered a citation that requires the person to appear at the court of the
45	magistrate with territorial jurisdiction.
46	(2) The following may issue the citation [may be issued by] described in Subsection
47	<u>(1)</u> :
48	[(1)] (a) a peace officer, in lieu of or in addition to taking the person into custody;
49	[(2)] (b) any public official of any county or municipality charged with the enforcemen
50	of the law;
51	[(3)] <u>(c)</u> a port-of-entry agent as defined in Section 72-1-102;
52	[(4)] (d) an animal control officer of a county, municipality, or special service district
53	under Title 17D, Chapter 1, Special Service District Act, who is authorized to provide animal
54	control service; and
55	[(5)] (e) a volunteer authorized to issue a citation under Section 41-6a-213.
