7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill amends provisions to allow a certain amount of class B and class C road funds
10 for maintenance and development of additional roads that may be added to class B and
11 class C inventory, and administering, managing, and planning for class B, class C, or
12 class D roads and adjacent lands.

13 **Highlighted Provisions:**

14 This bill:

- 15 ▶ amends provisions related to class B and class C road funds to allow a portion of
16 those funds for:
- 17 • maintenance and development of class D roads to be added to the class B and C
18 road inventory; and
 - 19 • administering, managing, and planning the class B, class C, and class D road
20 networks and adjacent lands.

29 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

30 Section 1. Section **72-2-110** is amended to read:

31 **72-2-110. Funds allocated to class B and class C roads -- Matching federal funds**
32 **-- R.S. 2477 rights.**

33 A county or municipality may:

34 (1) use funds which are allocated to class B and class C roads for matching federal
35 funds for the construction of secondary roads now available or which may later become
36 available in accordance with the provisions of law; and

37 (2) use up to 30% of the class B and class C road funds allocated to the county or
38 municipality to:

39 (a) pay the costs of asserting, defending, or litigating local government rights under
40 R.S. 2477 on class B, class C, or class D roads[?];

41 (b) maintain or develop class D roads to be added to the class B or class C inventory;

42 or

43 (c) administer, manage, and plan the class B, class C, and class D road networks and
44 lands adjacent thereto.
