LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies provisions of the Cosmetology and Associated Professions Licensing Act (the act).

- ▶ modifies the number of apprentices that a supervisor may supervise under the act;

- ▶ makes technical changes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **58-11a-306** is amended to read:



28 **58-11a-306. Apprenticeship.**

29 (1) An approved barber apprenticeship shall:

30 (a) consist of not less than [~~1,250~~] 1,000 hours of training in not less than [~~eight~~] six
31 months; and

32 (b) be conducted by a supervisor who:

33 (i) is licensed under this chapter as a barber instructor or a cosmetology/barber
34 instructor; [~~and~~]

35 (ii) provides [~~one-on-one~~] direct supervision of the barber apprentice during the
36 apprenticeship program[~~;~~]; and

37 (iii) provides direct supervision to no more than four barber apprentices during the
38 apprentice program.

39 (2) An approved cosmetologist/barber apprenticeship shall:

40 (a) consist of not less than [~~2,500~~] 1,600 hours of training in not less than [~~15~~] 10
41 months; and

42 (b) be conducted by a supervisor who:

43 (i) is licensed under this chapter as a cosmetologist/barber instructor; [~~and~~]

44 (ii) provides [~~one-on-one~~] direct supervision of the cosmetologist/barber apprentice
45 during the apprenticeship program[~~;~~]; and

46 (iii) provides direct supervision to no more than four cosmetologist/barber apprentices
47 during the apprentice program.

48 (3) An approved esthetician apprenticeship shall:

49 (a) consist of not less than [~~800~~] 600 hours of training in not less than [~~five~~] four
50 months; and

51 (b) be conducted by a supervisor who:

52 (i) is licensed under this chapter as an esthetician instructor; [~~and~~]

53 (ii) provides [~~one-on-one~~] direct supervision of the esthetician apprentice during the
54 apprenticeship program[~~;~~]; and

55 (iii) provides direct supervision to no more than four esthetician apprentices during the
56 apprentice program.

57 (4) An approved master esthetician apprenticeship shall:

58 (a) consist of not less than [~~1,500~~] 1,200 hours of training in not less than [~~10~~] eight

59 months; and

60 (b) be conducted by a supervisor who:

61 (i) is licensed under this chapter as a master-level esthetician instructor; [~~and~~]

62 (ii) provides [~~one-on-one~~] direct supervision of the master esthetician apprentice

63 during the apprenticeship program[-]; and

64 (iii) provides direct supervision to no more than four master esthetician apprentices

65 during the apprenticeship program.

66 (5) An approved nail technician apprenticeship shall:

67 (a) consist of not less than [~~375~~] 300 hours of training in not less than [~~three~~] two

68 months; and

69 (b) be conducted by a supervisor who:

70 (i) is licensed under this chapter as a nail technician instructor or a cosmetology/barber

71 instructor; [~~and~~]

72 (ii) provides one-on-one direct supervision of the nail technician apprentice during the

73 apprenticeship program[-]; and

74 (iii) provides direct supervision to no more than four nail technician apprentices during

75 the apprentice program.

76 (6) A person seeking to qualify for licensure by apprenticing in an approved

77 apprenticeship under this chapter shall:

78 (a) register with the division before beginning the training requirements by:

79 (i) submitting a form prescribed by the division, which includes the name of the

80 licensed supervisor; and

81 (ii) paying a fee determined by the department under Section [63J-1-504](#);

82 (b) complete the apprenticeship within five years of the date on which the division

83 approves the registration; and

84 (c) notify the division within 30 days if the licensed supervisor changes after the

85 registration is approved by the division.

86 (7) Notwithstanding Subsection (6), if a person seeking to qualify for licensure by

87 apprenticing in an approved apprenticeship under this chapter [~~registers~~] is registered with the

88 division before January 1, 2017, any training requirements completed by the person as an

89 apprentice in an approved apprenticeship before registration may be applied to successful

90 completion of the approved apprenticeship.

91 (8) The division may make rules regarding the requirements of an approved
92 apprenticeship under this section if the rules:

93 (a) are made in accordance with Title 63G, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act; and

94 (b) ensure that the requirements to get a license through an approved apprenticeship are
95 substantially equivalent to the requirements to get a license by graduating from a recognized
96 school.
