29	(1) An approved barber apprenticeship shall:
30	(a) consist of not less than $[\frac{1,250}{2}]$ $\frac{1,000}{2}$ hours of training in not less than $[\frac{\text{eight}}{2}]$ $\frac{\text{six}}{2}$
31	months; and
32	(b) be conducted by a supervisor who:
33	(i) is licensed under this chapter as a barber instructor or a cosmetology/barber
