Mr. Speaker,

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 194**, HAZARDOUS MATERIALS EMERGENCY AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. B. Miles, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 28 through 35:*

- 28 (1) (a) The Hazardous Chemical Emergency Response Commission may recover
29 from
30 those persons whose negligent actions caused the hazardous materials emergency,
31 expenses
32 [~~incurred by state agencies~~] directly associated with a response to a hazardous materials
33 emergency taken under authority of this part, Title 53, Chapter 2a, Part 1, Emergency
34 Management Act, or Title 53, Chapter 2a, Part 2, Disaster Response and Recovery Act[-],
35 that
are incurred by:
(i) a state agency; ~~{-or-}~~ .
(ii) a political subdivision as defined in Subsection 53-2a-203(3) ~~{-}~~ ; or
(iii) an interlocal entity, described in Section 11-13-203, providing emergency
services to a political subdivision pursuant to written agreement.

2. *Page 2, Lines 41 through 43:*

- 41 (d) Any recovered costs shall be deposited in the General Fund as dedicated credits
42 to
43 be used by the division to reimburse ~~{-state and local government agencies or~~
~~political~~
~~subdivisions for the costs they have incurred.-}~~ an entity described in
Subsection (1)(a) for costs incurred by the entity.
