The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 265**, BODY CAMERA AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. McCay, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 16:*

- 12 This bill:
- 13 ▶ provides that recordings made by law enforcement officers while wearing a
- 14 body-worn camera may not be retained by a private entity if the private entity has
- 15 ownership in ~~{or authority to alter}~~ the recording; and
- 16 ▶ makes technical changes.

2. *Page 2, Lines 31 through 35:*

- 31 (b) Any recording made by an officer while on duty or acting in the officer's official
- 32 capacity as a law enforcement officer may not be retained, electronically or otherwise, by

- 34 ~~(i)}~~ has any ownership or reasonable expectancy of ownership in the
