Mr. Speaker,

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 407**, ASSISTANCE ANIMALS AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. A. Dunnigan, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. Page 4, Lines 110 through 114:

- 110 (b) (i) { This section does not prohibit an } An owner or lessor of private housing
- accommodations { from charging a person, including [a person] an individual with a disability, a
- 112 reasonable deposit as security for any damage or wear and tear that might be caused by a
- service animal <u>or assistance animal</u> if the owner or lessor would charge a similar deposit to
- other persons for potential wear and tear. \ may charge a person, including an individual with a disability who is accompanied by a service animal or an assistance animal, the same security deposit for wear and tear that the owner or lessor charges to other persons who are not accompanied by a service animal or an assistance animal.
  - (ii) An owner or lessor of private housing may not charge an extra fee or deposit for a service or assistant animal.
