The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **S.B. 91**, ANIMAL WELFARE AMENDMENTS, by Senator G. Davis, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 91**, ANIMAL WELFARE AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Line 81 through 84:*

- 81 (h) (i) "Shelter," as the term relates to an animal other than a dog or cat, means —
82 **in counties of the first class,** natural
82 or artificial protection against inclement weather and direct sunlight.
83 (ii) "Shelter," as it relates to a dog or cat, means —, **in counties of the first class,**
83 a barn, dog house, or other enclosed
84 structure that:

2. *Page 4, Line 94 through 96:*

- 94 (iii) "Shelter" does not include —, **in counties of the first class** ;
95 (A) a crawl space;
96 (B) the space under a vehicle;
