1. *Page 4, Lines 103 through 107:*

103 (b) A service provider may comply with Subsection (1)(a) by engaging a third party
to
104 provide [~~software, or referring users to a third party that provides filtering software, by~~
105 ~~providing a clear and conspicuous hyperlink or written statement, for installation on the~~
106 ~~consumer's computer that blocks, in an easy-to-enable and commercially reasonable~~
manner;] , or referring a consumer to a third party that provides, a
107 commercially reasonable method of filtering to block the receipt of material harmful to
minors.
