## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 5, 2018

Mr. Speaker,

The Revenue and Taxation Committee has returned **S.B. 146**, TECHNOLOGY SUMMIT INCENTIVES, by Senator J. L. Anderegg to the Rules Committee and with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 6, Lines 157 through 165:
  - (1) There is created a restricted account within the General Fund known as the
  - 158 "Industrial Assistance Account" of which <u>annually</u>:
  - (a) up to 50% of the unencumbered money in the account may be used in economically
  - 160 disadvantaged rural areas;
  - 161 (b) up to [25%] the greater of unencumbered money in the \$\frac{\$1,000,000}{\$1,000,000}\$} \frac{\$500,000}{\$000} \text{ or 25% of the unencumbered money in the}
  - 162 <u>account</u> may be used to take timely advantage of economic opportunities as they arise; and
  - (c) up to 4% of the unencumbered money in the account may be used to promote
  - business and economic development in rural areas of the state with the Business Expansion and
  - 165 Retention Initiative.
