

# H.B. 256

## ELECTRIC SERVICE DISTRICT

Senator **Jerry W. Stevenson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 18 through 20:*

18 Other Special Clauses:  
19 This bill provides a special effective date.

2. *Page 3, Lines 70 through 73:*

70 (2) Beginning { ~~on this bill's effective date~~ } April 1, 2019, without a written agreement that
