41	(d) alternative treatments that may be available; and		
42	(e) other risks associated with the use of the drugs being prescribed.		
{ -43	(3) This section does not apply to a prescription for:		
44	<u>(a) a patient who is currently in active treatment for cancer;</u>		
45	(b) a patient who is receiving hospice care from a licensed hospice; or		
46	<u>(c) a medication that is being prescribed to a patient for the treatment of the patient's</u>		
47	substance abuse or opiate dependence. }
