Senator Wayne A. Harper proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 15a
 Senate Committee Amendments
 1-25-2018:
 - This bill:
 - requires a waiver of a fine for a violation for failure to display Ŝ→ <u>a license plate or</u> ←Ŝ registration decals if:
 - the vehicle was properly registered at the time of the citation; and
 - the person cited provides evidence $\underline{, within 21 business days,}$ that the $\hat{S} \rightarrow \underline{license}$ plate and $\leftarrow \hat{S}$ decals have
 - 15a been properly displayed {--} ; and
 - ▶ allows a year decal to be displayed over or in place of the previous year sticker.
- 2. Page 3, Line 82 through Page 4, Line 91:
 - 82 (8) The current year decal issued in accordance with Subsection (5) shall be placed
 - 83 over **or in place of** the previous year decal.
 - 84 (9) If a license plate, month decal, or year decal is lost or destroyed, a replacement shall
 - be issued upon application and payment of the fees required under Section 41-1a-1211 or
 - 86 41-1a-1212.
 - 87 (10) (a) A violation of this section is an infraction.
 - (b) A court shall waive a fine for a violation under this section if:
 - (i) the registration for the vehicle was current at the time of the citation; and
 - 90 (ii) the person to whom the citation was issued provides , within 21 business days, evidence that the \$\hat{S} \rightharpoonup license plate
 - 90a and ←Ŝ decals are
 - 91 properly displayed in compliance with this section.
