**SCHOOL COUNSELOR SERVICES**

2019 GENERAL SESSION

**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill directs the State Board of Education to adopt rules regarding school counselors.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ directs the State Board of Education to adopt rules:
  - regarding certain services provided by school counselors; and
  - prohibiting school counselors from certain activities; and
- ▶ requires the State Board of Education to report to the Education Interim Committee on the board's efforts to address school counseling services.

**Other Special Clauses:**

This bill provides a coordination clause.

96 Counsel prepare the Utah Code database for publication by:

97            (1) inserting the following language as Subsection 53E-1-201(2)(a):

98            "(a) the report described in Section [53E-3-518](#) by the state board regarding counseling  
99 services in schools;"; and

100            (2) renumbering remaining subsections accordingly.
