Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section <b>53G-7-217</b> is enacted to read:
53G-7-217. Local education agency Medicaid reimbursements.
(1) (a) If an LEA receives Medicaid reimbursement for services provided to eligible
students, the LEA shall annually certify to the state board that each Medicaid reimbursement
the LEA received was used only to cover the cost of the service for which reimbursement was
approved.
(b) An LEA may only use a Medicaid reimbursement to:
(i) enhance the compensation of an employee who provided the associated Medicaid
covered service to an eligible student; or
(ii) reimburse a contracted provider who provided the associated Medicaid covered
service to an eligible student.
(2) (a) Beginning January 1, 2021, and except as provided in Subsection (2)(b), an
LEA may not receive a Medicaid reimbursement for administrative costs as allowed by the
Medicaid program.
(b) On behalf of an LEA, the state board shall enter into an agreement for Medicaid
reimbursement for administrative costs and submit administrative reimbursement requests as
allowed by the Medicaid program.
