LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill enacts provisions related to Medicaid reimbursements to public schools.

► provides that, beginning on January 1, 2021, the State Board of Education shall submit Medicaid reimbursement requests on behalf of public schools for allowable administrative costs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53G-7-217** is enacted to read:

53G-7-217. Local education agency Medicaid reimbursements.



26 (1) Beginning January 1, 2021, and except as provided in Subsection (2), an LEA may
27 not receive a Medicaid reimbursement for administrative costs as allowed by the Medicaid
28 program.

29 (2) On behalf of an LEA, the state board shall:

30 (a) enter into an agreement for Medicaid reimbursement for administrative costs; and

31 (b) submit administrative reimbursement requests as allowed by the Medicaid program.
