- prohibits a local education agency from using Medicaid reimbursements except:
 - to enhance the compensation of an employee who provided the reimbursable service; or
 - to reimburse a contracted provider for providing the reimbursable service; and
- Provides that, beginning on January 1, 2021, the State Board of Education shall

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submit Medicaid reimbursement requests on behalf of public schools for allowable administrative costs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53G-7-217** is enacted to read:

53G-7-217. Local education agency Medicaid reimbursements.

{ (1) As used in this section, "medically related professional" means a speech-language pathologist or audiologist who provides a service that is eligible for Medicaid reimbursement.

(2) (a) If an LEA receives Medicaid reimbursement for services provided to eligible students, the LEA shall annually certify to the state board that each Medicaid reimbursement the LEA received was used only to cover the cost of the service for which reimbursement was approved.

(b) An LEA may only use a Medicaid reimbursement to:

(i) enhance the compensation of an employee who provided the associated Medicaid covered service to an eligible student; or

<u>(ii) reimburse a contracted provider who provided the associated Medicaid covered</u> service to an eligible student.

(c) An LEA shall pay a medically related professional on a separate salary schedule from teachers.

({b}<u>2</u>) On behalf of an LEA, the state board shall:

(fi)a) enter into an agreement for Medicaid reimbursement for administrative costs;

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and

(firb) submit administrative reimbursement requests as allowed by the Medicaid
