LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires the State Board of Regents to study and report to the Legislature on tuition waivers and scholarships.

- ▶ provides a repeal date.

30 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

31 Section 1. Section **53B-8-114** is enacted to read:

32 **53B-8-114. Study of tuition waivers and scholarships -- Report to Legislature.**

33 (1) The board shall study the statewide impacts of state-created tuition waivers and
34 scholarships, including:

35 (a) the amount of tuition waived and scholarships granted, including the proportion of
36 tuition waivers and scholarships for resident students and nonresident students;

37 (b) the benefits and fiscal impacts of state-created tuition waivers and scholarships;

38 (c) the process by which students apply for tuition waivers and scholarships, and
39 whether that process can be consolidated across higher education institutions that are part of
40 the Utah System of Higher Education described in Section [53B-1-102](#);

41 (d) the performance of students who receive state-created tuition waivers or state
42 scholarships, including retention, completion and state workforce participation; and

43 (e) other issues related to the statewide goals and impacts of tuition waivers and
44 scholarships, as determined by the board.

45 (2) On or before November 1, 2019, the board shall report to the Higher Education
46 Appropriations Subcommittee on:

47 (a) the results of the study described in Subsection (1); and

48 (b) any recommendations related to tuition waivers and scholarships based on the
49 results.

101 Section 3. **Coordinating H.B. 454 with S.B. 14 -- Substantive language.**

102 If this H.B. 454 and S.B. 14, Education Reporting Requirements, both pass and become
103 law, it is the intent of the Legislature that the Office of Legislative Research and General
104 Counsel prepare the Utah Code database for publication by:

105 (1) inserting the following language as a new Subsection [53B-1-301\(2\)\(a\)](#):

106 "(a) the report by the State Board of Regents on a study of tuition waivers and
107 scholarships described in Section [53B-8-114](#);"; and

108 (2) renumbering remaining subsections accordingly.
