LONG TITLE

General Description:

This joint resolution of the Legislature proposes to amend the Utah Constitution to modify a provision relating to the State Board of Education.

Highlighted Provisions:

This resolution proposes to amend the Utah Constitution to:

- ▶ provide that State Board of Education members shall be elected or appointed as provided by statute.

Special Clauses:

This resolution directs the lieutenant governor to submit this proposal to voters.

This resolution provides a contingent effective date of January 1, 2021 for this proposal.

Utah Constitution Sections Affected:

AMENDS:

ARTICLE X, SECTION 3

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, two-thirds of all members elected to each of the two houses voting in favor thereof:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Utah Constitution, Article X, Section 3, to read:



26 **Article X, Section 3. [State Board of Education.]**

27 The general control and supervision of the public education system shall be vested in a
28 State Board of Education. The membership of the board shall be established, and shall be
29 elected or appointed, as provided by statute. The State Board of Education shall appoint a
30 State Superintendent of Public Instruction who shall be the executive officer of the board.

31 **Section 2. Submittal to voters.**

32 The lieutenant governor is directed to submit this proposed amendment to the voters of
33 the state at the next regular general election in the manner provided by law.

34 **Section 3. Contingent effective date.**

35 If the amendment proposed by this joint resolution is approved by a majority of those
36 voting on it at the next regular general election, the amendment shall take effect on January 1,
37 2021.
