Committee Note:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Interim Committee recommended this bill.

This bill relates to a peace officer's authority to stop and question a suspect of a crime.

77-7-15, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2018, Chapter 281

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **77-7-15** is amended to read:

77-7-15. Authority of peace officer to stop and question suspect -- Grounds.



28 A peace officer may stop any [~~person~~] individual in a public place when the officer has
29 a reasonable suspicion to believe the [~~person~~] individual has committed or is in the act of
30 committing or is attempting to commit a public offense and may demand the [~~person's~~]
31 individual's name, address, date of birth, and an explanation of the [~~person's~~] individual's
32 actions.
