LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires the lieutenant governor to employ an attorney responsible for Native American issues.

- ▶ requires the attorney to serve as a resource to the state and each county; and
- ▶ makes technical changes.

67-1a-3, as enacted by Laws of Utah 1984, Chapter 68

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **67-1a-3** is amended to read:

67-1a-3. Employment of personnel.



28 (1) The lieutenant governor, with the approval of the governor, may employ personnel
29 necessary to carry out the duties and responsibilities of his office.

30 (2) The lieutenant governor shall:

31 (a) employ an attorney whose sole responsibilities relate to legal issues regarding
32 Native American tribes; and

33 (b) ensure that the attorney described in Subsection (2)(a) serves as a resource to the
34 state and each county.
