Mr. President,

The Retirement and Independent Entities Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 30**, UTAH RETIREMENT SYSTEMS AMENDMENTS, by Representative A. Robertson, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 17, Lines 499 through 501:
 - 499 (1) one council member shall be a special district officer or employee selected by the
 - 500 governing board of the association
 {<u>representative of a majority</u>}

 representing the largest number
 of special service districts and
 - 501 local districts who participate in a system administered by the board.
- 2. Page 19, Lines 564 through 566:
 - 564 (2) (a) (i) A justice court judge who has service with only one participating employer shall

 - 566 <u>employment facts and circumstances</u> certified by the participating employer {-<u>to the office</u>}.

<u>(ii) If there is a dispute between the office and a participating employer or</u> <u>justice court judge over whether service is full-time or part-time for any</u> <u>employment period, the disputed service shall be submitted by the office to the</u> <u>Administrative Office of the Courts for determination.</u>







- 3. Page 22, Lines 673 through 675:
 - 673 (2) (a) (i) A justice court judge who has service with only one participating employer shall

 - 675 <u>employment facts and circumstances</u>} certified by the participating employer {<u>to the office</u>}.

<u>(ii) If there is a dispute between the office and a participating employer or</u> <u>justice court judge over whether service is full-time or part-time for any</u> <u>employment period, the disputed service shall be submitted by the office to the</u> <u>Administrative Office of the Courts for determination.</u>
