The Judiciary Committee recommends **H.B. 57**, ELECTRONIC INFORMATION OR DATA PRIVACY, by Representative C. Hall, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **3rd Sub**. **H.B. 57**, ELECTRONIC INFORMATION OR DATA PRIVACY with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 4, Lines 98 through 100:
  - 98 (ii) is {<u>incidentally</u>} collected as part of an effort to obtain the location information,
  - 99 <u>stored data, transmitted data of an electronic device, or electronic information or data</u> <u>provided</u>
  - 100 by a remote computing service provider that is the subject of the warrant in Subsection (1)(a).
- 2. Page 8, Lines 238 through 242:
  - 238 <u>77-23c-105.</u> Exclusion of records.
  - All electronic information or data and records of a provider of an electronic
  - 240 <u>communications service or remote computing service pertaining to a subscriber or customer</u>
  - 241 <u>that are obtained in violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be excluded</u> <u>subject to the rules governing exclusion</u> as if the records
  - 242 were obtained in violation of the Fourth Amendment to the United States Constitution and
