The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 114**, SELF-DEFENSE AMENDMENTS, by Representative A. Cory Maloy, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 13:*

11 This bill:  
12 ▶ provides that an individual is not required to retreat from an aggressor {~~even~~  
~~if there~~  
13 ~~is a safe place to which the individual can retreat~~} ;

2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 80:*

78 (a) an individual does not have a duty to retreat from the force or threatened force  
79 described in Subsection (2) in a place where that individual has lawfully entered or  
remained  
80 {~~even if safety could be achieved by retreating~~} ; and

3. *Page 4, Lines 108 through 109:*

108 (2) Except as otherwise provided in Section 76-2-402 and for {~~those [persons]~~  
109 ~~individuals~~} an invididual described in Section 76-10-503, [a person] an
