The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 230**, EXEMPTIONS FROM COLLECTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. J. Stratton, with the following amendments and recommends it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 3, Lines 60 through 73:
 - 60 {<u>(e) (i) As used in this Subsection (2)(e), "index number" means the average</u> of the four
 - 61 <u>most recent quarterly index numbers for the not seasonally adjusted, purchase-only</u> <u>House Price</u>
 - 62 <u>Index for Utah as published in the House Price Index Report for the third quarter</u> by the Federal
 - 63 <u>Housing Finance Agency in the year previous to the calendar year that is calculated</u> in
 - 64 <u>Subsection (2)(e)(iii).</u>
 - 65 <u>(ii) The dollar amounts in Subsections (2)(a) and (b) are for May 14, 2019,</u> <u>through</u>
 - 66 <u>December 31, 2019.</u>
 - 67 <u>(iii) For the calendar year 2020 and a calendar year after the calendar year</u> <u>2020, the</u>
 - 68 <u>state auditor shall:</u>
 - 69 <u>(A) calculate new dollar amounts for Subsections (2)(a) and (b) by multiplying</u> the

- 70 <u>dollar amount in Subsections (2)(a) and (b) by the index number, dividing the result</u> by 400,
- 71 <u>and rounding to the nearest 100 dollars; and</u>
- 72 (B) publish on the Office of the State Auditor website the new dollar amounts
- 73 <u>calculated under Subsection (2)(e)(iii) no later than January 1 of the applicable</u> <u>calendar year.</u>}
