The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 291**, CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT MODIFICATIONS, by Representative M. Winder, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. *Page 3, Lines 70 through 75:*

concurrent enrollment offerings in all college service areas.
