The Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee recommends **H.B. 307**, UTILITY ONLINE USAGE DATA AMENDMENTS, by Representative E. K. Hutchings, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 307**, UTILITY ONLINE USAGE DATA AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 16:*

- 12 This bill:
- 13 ▶ if available and requested by the customer, requires an electrical corporation to
- 14 provide the nonresidential customer access to the customer's usage data in:
- 15 • 15 minute intervals; or
- 16 • the shortest requested interval available through existing meters; and

2. *Page 2, Lines 44 through 50:*

- 44 (4) (a) If requested by a nonresidential customer, and to the extent available through
- 45 existing meters, each electrical corporation shall provide the nonresidential customer
- 46 access to
- 47 the customer's usage data.
- 48 (b) Each electrical corporation shall provide the access described in Subsection
- 49 (4)(a)
- 48 broken down into:
- 49 (i) 15 minute intervals; or
- 50 (ii) the shortest requested interval available through existing meters.
