The Transportation, Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.C.R. 3**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO UPDATE SWITCHER LOCOMOTIVE EMISSION STANDARDS, by Representative S. G. Handy, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 1 through 3:

- 4. Page 2, Lines 45 through 49:
  - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the
  - 46 Governor concurring therein, hereby requests that { the EPA develop and make more stringent
  - 47 switcher locomotive emissions standards requiring Congress allow states to regulate switcher locomotive emissions standards so that a state can require that Tier 0 and 0+ locomotives be
  - 48 repowered to meet Tier 4 standards or otherwise be retired in a timely and cost-effective
  - 49 manner.
