Mr. President,

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.C.R. 6**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING MAY 5 AS MISSING AND MURDERED INDIGENOUS WOMEN, GIRLS, AND LGBT+ AWARENESS DAY, by Representative A. Romero, with the following amendments and recommends it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 2, Lines 35 through 41:
 - 35 (2) remained a leading cause of death for most Native American females between 40
 - and 64 years of age;
 - 37 { WHEREAS, according to a 2018 report by the Urban Indian Health Institute, Utah is
 - 38 ranked 8th and Salt Lake City is ranked 9th nationwide for cases of missing and murdered
 - 39 Native American women, girls, and LGBT+;-}
 - WHEREAS, challenges in collecting data and tracking prevent a full understanding of
 - 41 the scope of the crisis of missing and murdered indigenous women, girls, and LGBT+;
