The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.C.R. 6**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING MAY 5 AS MISSING AND MURDERED INDIGENOUS WOMEN, GIRLS, AND LGBT+ AWARENESS DAY, by Representative A.
