The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.C.R. 10**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO ADDRESS DECLINING WATER LEVELS OF THE GREAT SALT LAKE, by Representative T. D. Hawkes, with the following amendments and recommends it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. *Page 2, Lines 37 through 39:*

37 WHEREAS, the "lake effect" from Great Salt Lake provides an important

2. *Page 3, Lines 64 through 67:*

64 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor recognize
there is
65 a need for an overall policy that supports effective {~~allocation and~~} administration
of water flow
66 to Great Salt Lake to maintain or increase lake levels, while appropriately balancing
economic,
67 social, and environmental needs , including the need to sustain working agricultural
