Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 170, PHARMACY AND PHARMACEUTICALS AMENDMENTS**, by Senator E. J. Vickers, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 12:*

12 ▶ amends the definition of "closed door pharmacy" and "practice as a licensed pharmacy technician";

2. *Page 4, Lines 88 through 92:*

88 (15) (i) "Closed-door pharmacy" means a pharmacy that :
89 (A) provides pharmaceutical care to a
90 defined and exclusive group of patients who have access to the services of the pharmacy
91 because they are treated by or have an affiliation with a specific entity, including a health
92 maintenance organization or an infusion company {, but not including} ; or
(B) engages exclusively in the practice of telepharmacy and does not serve walk-in retail customers.
(ii) "Closed-door pharmacy" does not include a hospital pharmacy, a
92 retailer of goods to the general public, or the office of a practitioner.
