(a) <u>before the review, directly inform the chairs of the Administrative Rules Review Committee</u> of the coming review, including the date, time, and place of the review; and

(b) <u>after the review, directly inform the chairs of the Administrative Rules Review Committee</u> of the outcome of the review, including any recommendation.
