

# H.B. 94

## WEAPONS RESTRICTIONS AMENDMENTS

Representative **Norman K. Thurston** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 19:*

12 This bill:

\* \* \* *Some lines not shown* \* \* \*

18     ▶ provides an exception for an individual who carries a dangerous weapon ~~{on}~~ **in a**  
private **residence**  
19 ~~{property}~~ with the consent of the owner.

2. *Page 2, Lines 32 through 34:*

32     (1) Except for Sections 76-10-506, 76-10-508, [and] 76-10-508.1, ~~{and 76-10-528,}~~ this  
33 part and Title 53, Chapter 5, Part 7, Concealed Firearm Act, do not apply to any of the  
34 following:

3. *Page 2, Lines 40 through 46:*

40     (f) a common carrier while engaged in the regular and ordinary transport of firearms as  
41 merchandise.

**(2) Notwithstanding Subsection (1), the provisions of Section 76-10-528 apply to any individual listed in Subsection (1) who is not employed by a state or federal agency or political subdivision that has adopted a policy or rule regarding the use of dangerous weapons.**

42     ~~{(2)}~~ **(3)** The provisions of Subsections 76-10-504(1) and (2), and Section 76-10-505 do not  
43 apply to any person to whom a permit to carry a concealed firearm has been issued:

44     (a) pursuant to Section 53-5-704; or

45     (b) by another state or county.

46     ~~{(3)}~~ **(4)** Except for Sections 76-10-503, 76-10-506, 76-10-508, and 76-10-508.1, this part

61     (2) This section does not apply to:
