Page 1, Lines 12 through 19: 12 This bill: * * * Some lines not shown * * * 18 provides an exception for an individual who carries a dangerous weapon {-on-} in a private residence 19 {-property-} with the consent of the owner. Page 2, Lines 32 through 34: (1) Except for Sections 76-10-506, 76-10-508, [and] 76-10-508.1, {and 76-10-528,} 32 this 33 part and Title 53, Chapter 5, Part 7, Concealed Firearm Act, do not apply to any of the 34 following: Page 2, Lines 40 through 46: 40 (f) a common carrier while engaged in the regular and ordinary transport of firearms as 41 merchandise. (2) Notwithstanding Subsection (1), the provisions of Section 76-10-528 apply to any individual listed in Subsection (1) who is not employed by a state or federal agency or political subdivision that has adopted a policy or rule regarding the use of dangerous weapons. 42 The provisions of Subsections 76-10-504(1) and (2), and Section 76-10-505 do not {(2)} (3) 43 apply to any person to whom a permit to carry a concealed firearm has been issued: (a) pursuant to Section 53-5-704; or 44 45 (b) by another state or county. (4) Except for Sections 76-10-503, 76-10-506, 76-10-508, and 76-10-508.1, this part 46 {(3)-} Page 3, Lines 61 through 68: 61 (2) This section does not apply to: * * * Some lines not shown * * * 66 (c) any person carrying a dangerous weapon in { or on} the person's residence { or property,

a business under the person's control, or the residence of another with the consent of the
