 - 181 exiting homelessness[:] and;

(xii) providing medical respite care for homeless individuals where the homeless individuals can access medical care and other supportive services; and

 - [(8)] (7) (a) As used in this Subsection [(8)] (7) and in Subsection [(9)] (8), "homeless
 - shelter" means a facility that:
 - (i) is located within a municipality; and
 - 215 (ii) provides temporary shelter year-round to homeless individuals { ; and } including an emergency shelter or medical respite facility.
 - 216 { (iii) has the capacity to provide temporary shelter to at least 50 individuals per night.}
