Representative **Melissa Garff Ballard** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 24 through Page 2, Line 26:*

24 Other Special Clauses:

3. *Page 4, Line 112:*

112 Transportation will help address unsafe or hazardous routes for students who walk to school.

Section 2. Coordinating H.B. 363 with S.B. 14 -- Substantive amendment.

If this H.B. 363 and S.B. 14, Education Reporting Requirements, both pass and become law, it is the intent of the Legislature that the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel prepare the Utah Code database for publication by:

(1) inserting the following language as a new Subsection 53E-1-201(2)(f):

"(f) the reports described in Section 53F-2-403 by the state board and the Department of Transportation regarding unsafe or hazardous routes for students who walk to school;"; and

(2) renumbering remaining subsections accordingly.
