

1st Sub. S.B. 96
MEDICAID EXPANSION ADJUSTMENTS

Senator **Luz Escamilla** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 21 through 23:*

- 21 • imposes a lock-out period for individuals who violate certain program
22 requirements; and
23 • gives enrollees continuous eligibility for a period of 12 months; ~~{and}~~
▶ if the waiver requested under this bill is not approved by April 1, 2020:
• directs the department to expand Medicaid eligibility to the full optional population under the
Affordable Care Act; and
• prohibits the department from implementing any waivers requested under this bill;

2. *Page 8, Lines 230 through 231:*

- 230 (d) "Medicaid waiver expansion" means a Medicaid expansion in accordance with this
231 section[-] or Section 26-18-3.9.
(e) "PPACA" means the same as that term is defined in Section 31A-1-301.

3. *Page 11, Line 305:*

- 305 (d) recommendations to control costs of the Medicaid waiver expansion.
(8) (a) If the department does not receive approval from CMS for the waiver described in Subsection
(2) or (3) on or before April 1, 2020:
(i) the state shall amend the state Medicaid plan to expand Medicaid eligibility to the full optional
Medicaid expansion population under PPACA; and
(ii) the department may not implement any provision described in:
(A) Subsections (2) through (7); or
(B) Section 26-18-3.9.
(b) The requirements described in Sections 26-18-18 and 63J-5-204 do not apply to an expansion
under this Subsection (8).
