MEDICAID EXPANSION ADJUSTMENTS

Senator **Luz Escamilla** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 24:*

- 24 • allows Medicaid funds to be used for housing supports for certain enrollees;
- ▶ if the waiver requested under this bill is not approved by April 1, 2020:
 - directs the department to expand Medicaid eligibility to the full optional population under the Affordable Care Act; and
 - prohibits the department from implementing any waivers requested under this bill;

2. *Page 5, Lines 132 through 133:*

- 132 (c) "Medicaid expansion" means an expansion of the Medicaid program in accordance
- 133 with this section.
- (d) "PPACA" means the same as that term is defined in Section 31A-1-301.

3. *Page 9, Line 253:*

- 253 (d) recommendations to control costs of the Medicaid expansion.
- (6) (a) If the department does not receive approval from CMS for the waiver described in Subsection (2)(b), (d), or (e) on or before April 1, 2020:
- (i) the state shall amend the state Medicaid plan to expand Medicaid eligibility to the full optional Medicaid expansion population under PPACA; and
 - (ii) the department may not implement any provision described in Subsection (2) or Section 26-18-415 that requires approval of a waiver from CMS.
- (b) The requirements described in Sections 26-18-18 and 63J-5-204 do not apply to an expansion under this Subsection (6).
