

S.B. 156

CONSTRUCTION TRADES LICENSING AMENDMENTS

Senator **Karen Mayne** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 62 through 69:*

62 (4) (a) The work and scope of practice covered by this Subsection (4) is the
63 installation, repair, maintenance, or replacement of an automatic fire sprinkler system.

64 (b) The provisions of this Subsection (4) apply to ~~{a licensee under this chapter whose~~
65 ~~license authorizes the licensee to}~~ an individual acting as a qualifier for a business entity in
accordance with Section 58-55-304, where the business entity seeks to perform the work described in
Subsection (4)(a).

66 (c) Before a ~~{licensee}~~ business entity described in Subsection (4)(b) may perform the work
described in
67 Subsection (4)(a), the ~~{licensee}~~ qualifier for the business entity shall obtain a certification in fire
sprinkler fitting from the
68 division by providing evidence to the division that the ~~{licensee}~~ qualifier has met the following

77 (d) The division may also issue a certification in fire sprinkler fitting to a ~~{licensee}~~ qualifier
for a business entity who
78 has received training and experience equivalent to the requirements of Subsection (4)(c), as
79 specified in rules adopted by the commission, with the concurrence of the director, in
80 accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act.

81 ~~{(e) An individual working under the immediate supervision of a licensee with a~~
82 ~~certification in fire sprinkler fitting does not need a certification in fire sprinkler fitting.}~~
